



Checklist for Developmental Coordination Disorder/ Dyspraxia

What are some of the signs of DCD?

- Difficulty adapting to the classroom routine
- Poor fine motor skills (pencil grip/use scissors, building with Legos, etc)
- Difficulty eating with knife and fork, tying shoelaces/buttons
- Illegible handwriting
- Poor listening and language skills
- Difficulty with sequential instruction
- Immature copying/drawings
- Slow completion of schoolwork
- Lack of imaginative play & limited creative play.
- Forming relationships
- Difficulty forming relationships and possible isolation/rejection by peers
- Becomes stressed/emotional often.
