

## Checklist for Developmental Coordination Disorder/ Dyspraxia

## What are some of the signs of DCD?

- · Difficulty adapting to the classroom routine
- · Poor fine motor skills (pencil grip/use scizzors, building with Legos, etc)
- · Difficulty eating with knife and fork, tying shoelaces/buttons
- · Illegible handwriting
- · Poor listening and language skills
- · Difficulty with sequential instruction
- · Immature copying/drawings
- · Slow completion of schoolwork
- · Lack of imaginative play &limited creative play.
- Forming relationships
- · Difficulty forming relationships and possible Isolation/rejection by peers
- · Becomes stressed/emotional often.
