



Checklist for Dysgraphia and Handwriting Difficulties

What are some of the signs?

- Illegible handwriting
- Poor posture and difficulty grasping the pencil correctly
- Frequent erasing or errors noted
- Written letters are poorly formed, inversed, reversed or inconsistently spaced
- Writes slowly compared to peers
- Unable to keep up with written demands
- Switching between cursive and print
- Inconsistencies with writing and spelling that cannot be explained
- Child may switch hands while writing
- Difficulty with written organisation of thought
- Previous intensive therapy with no real progress in handwriting
