# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### What is the ADOS?

ADOS stands for *Autism Diagnostic Observation Scale*. There are different scales depending on an individual's age and verbal fluency. During this part of the assessment, our therapists wil prepare the appropriate scale and accompanying activities/toys in one of our therapy rooms at Kids First. As your child engages with the materials, our therapists will be completing observations and guiding interaction with the materials, if indicated. You will be allowed in the room with your child during the entire ADOS assessment.

#### Who can refer?

We accept referrals from parents, schools, local GP's and other health professionals. fl you are unsure, or would like more information related to our clinics, please email: h.heerey@wordsfirst.uk

### Do you offer follow up intervention?

Yes! Our Autism Diagnostic Team will be able to refer you to our Speech and Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Play Therapy, Counselling or Educational Psychology services if required. Please note: The Autism Diagnostic Team do not provide follow up interventions; this wil be completed by ourcolleagues at the Kids First Clinic, or Words First Ltd therapists fi your child is in a school that accesses our services.

### How long does the appointment last?

You will be seen by our paediatrician prior to your in-person appointment at Kids First. We recommend allowing 3-4 hours for your Kids First appointment, as this will include the ADOS, supplementary assessments and discussion with you before/after. We also allow time for any breaks your child may need during the assessment.




